# Homeschool Laws & Requirements Canada

#### **Alberta**

#### Legal Requirement

Must notify a supervising school board or private early childhood services operator.

#### Supervision

Yes, by an associate board or private school.

#### **Funding: YES!**

Up to ~\$850 per child per year (varies). Funding is only available if registered with a willing associate board or private school.

#### Note:

Alberta is one of the most supportive provinces for homeschoolers

#### **British Columbia**

### **Legal Requirement**

Must register by September 30 with a school (public or independent). There are two options to do this:

- Registered homeschooler: Independent, no supervision.
- <u>Distributed learning (DL):</u> Enrolled in an online school, supervised, access to resources.

# **Supervision**

No, but parents can request evaluation and assessment from the registered school.

# **Funding: YES!**

Yes and no. The registered public and independent schools receive the funding. Private schools may give the money to the homeschool families at their discretion..

#### Manitoba

## Legal Requirement

Must submit a notification form and two reports per year to the government.

# **Supervision**

No formal supervision.

# **Funding**

No funding is available

#### **New Brunswick**

### **Legal Requirement**

Submit a notice of intent and annual form.

### Supervision

Minimal; no curriculum approval required.

**Funding: YES!** 

No funding available.

#### **Newfoundland & Labrador**

#### Legal Requirement

Must submit an application and education plan for approval each year.

#### **Supervision**

Yes, through the Department of Education.

## **Funding: YES!**

No funding available.

#### **Nova Scotia**

### **Legal Requirement**

Annual registration with the Department of Education.

# Supervision

Light oversight

## **Funding**

No funding is available

#### Ontario

# **Legal Requirement**

Submit a letter of intent to your local school board, if they're already enrolled. If they have previously nit been enrolled, you do not have to do anything

# Supervision

Minimal; board may follow up, approval is not needed. Otherwise no supervision.

# Funding

No funding is available

# **Homeschool Laws & Requirements Canada**

#### **Prince Edward Island**

### **Legal Requirement**

Must register with the Department of Education and submit a plan

### Supervision

Moderate; yearly progress must be shown.

#### **Funding:**

No funding available.

#### Québec

#### Legal Requirement

Must notify the Ministry of Education, submit a learning project, mid-year and final reports, and participate in an evaluation.

### **Supervision**

Yea, structured

# Funding:

No funding available.

#### Saskatchewan

## **Legal Requirement**

Must register with your school division and submit an educational plan.

# Supervision

Yes through local school divisions

# **Funding**

Some school divisions offer partial funding or resources

## Northwest Territories, Yukon, Nunavut

# **Legal Requirement**

Generally follow similar laws to their administering provinces (e.g., Yukon aligns closely with BC).

# **Funding**

May vary by territory and local school boards—often very limited or none.
